



POLICY N°2 - COMMUNICATION

Proposal by the EYP-network, 2014.

First approved on 26 May 2014.

Purpose and Applicability

§ 1 Purpose

This policy sets the guidelines ensuring a professional and integral use of communication by EYP Switzerland both within and outside of the organisation.

§ 2 Applicability

This policy applies to anyone communicating on behalf of EYP Switzerland, be it as a Board Member or as a participant of a session.

Political Neutrality

§ 3 Status

¹ EYP Switzerland is a politically and religiously neutral organisation.

² EYP Switzerland does not associate itself with the opinions of political parties, national governments, international organisations and NGOs in order to guarantee that EYP remains an independent, non-partisan educational programme.

³ Volunteers in EYP Switzerland are obliged to act in a politically neutral manner when holding official roles at EYP sessions or representing EYP.

⁴ EYP Switzerland is not allowed to express any political opinion in its official communications.

Languages of EYP

§ 4 Use of Language

¹ All official languages of Switzerland, and English, can be used in EYP Switzerland's communication.



² The working language of EYP Switzerland is English.

Logos

§ 5 Use of Logos

EYP Switzerland must distinguish its logo from the EYP one by adding the name of the country or organisation.

Approved in Bulle, 30 June 2019 by the Board of EYP Switzerland.

This policy takes precedence over older documents. Unless explicitly specified otherwise, this policy enters into force immediately following its approval.
